- 2. The scientific abstract should be submitted only by email to forum2024@smfhospital.org
- 3. A delegate can present only one oral paper. Poster presentation can be additional.
- 4. Material for projection should be handed over at the conference venue on 27/4/2024.
- 5. Each candidate will get a maximum of 6 minutes for presentation.
- 6. The presentation will be done on 27/4/2024. The time and venue will be intimated later.
- 7. Two minutes will be allotted after each presentation for discussion and to field questions from the moderator and audience.
- 8. Presentations will be made from a common computer. Use of personal laptops will not be permitted.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

- 1. Name and photograph of the presenter should be on the right upper corner of the poster.
- 2. If a post graduate is making the presentation, the name of the teacher and the institution should not be mentioned on the poster.
